PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR  
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER  
AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF;  
AND MOTION FOR ORDER  
TO SHOW CAUSE WHY A  
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION  
SHOULD NOT ISSUE

COMES NOW, Plaintiff Bryan Reo, and hereby moves this Court pursuant to SDCL 15-6-65 for a Temporary Restraining Order, and requests this Court issue and Order pursuant to SDCL Ch. 21-8 requiring Defendants to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not issue.

Plaintiff requests a Temporary Restraining order and Order to Show Cause restraining and compelling the Defendants in the following manner:

1. Restraining either of the Defendants, their agents, contractors, licensees, beneficiaries, lessees, or any other person have any authority to act on their behalf from transferring or encumbering any of the real property in the following legal description in Stanley County:

**Township 7 North, Range 26 East of the Black Hills Meridian,  
Stanley County, South Dakota:**

- Section 34:**  
That portion of the NE1/4NE1/4 lying in the South and West of the Highway Right of Way;  
SE 1/4NE1/4, NE1/4SE1/4.
- Section 35:**  
That portion of the NW1/4, SW1/4, SE1/4, lying South and West of the Highway Right-of-way; and

**Township 6 North, Range 26 East of the Black Hills Meridian,  
Stanley County, South Dakota:**

- Section 2:**  
Lots 1,2,3,4, S1/2N1/2, S1/2 (all);
- Section 11:**

NW1/4, NE1/4, SE1/4;  
**Section 14:**  
NW1/4, N1/2SE1/4

2. Requiring Defendants, their agents, contractors, licensees, beneficiaries, lessees, or any other person having authority to act on behalf of the Defendants to serve copies of the requested orders on all personnel involved in any activity relating to the parcels of real property described herein.



4. Providing other equitable relief as this court sees fit and just.

5. For attorneys fees, costs disbursements and the like.
