On May 20, 2020, we struck Lindstedt's amended brief and ordered him to file a new and compliant brief. Lindstedt filed his amended brief June 4, 2020, and Reo again moves to dismiss or strike the brief. Reo contends that the newest brief fails to cite legal authority and the record and that Lindstedt continues to raise arguments on behalf of the Church of Jesus Christ Christian/Aryan Nations of Missouri (the church).

Lindstedt opposes and moves us to accept his third amended appellate brief and asks this court to overturn the trial court's judgment, arguing the merits of the appeal, and he asks us to punish Reo for pursuing this motion.

Lindstedt's June 4, 2020 brief largely complies with our orders. He removed the derogatory and abusive language and mostly complies with our directives regarding raising arguments on behalf of the church. And although limited, Lindstedt includes some references to the record and legal authority. To the extent any argument is unsupported, we will address it accordingly. And to

the extent Lindstedt, a non-attorney, raises arguments on behalf of the church, we will address this as necessary.

Our prior orders continue to govern all filings herein and Lindstedt's filings in all other proceedings before this court. Lindstedt shall continue to exclude abusive and inflammatory language and name calling in his reply brief and all future court filings.

Thus, we overrule Reo's motion to dismiss and strike Lindstedt's June 4, 2020 brief.

We likewise overrule Lindstedt's June 22, 2020 motion seeking to punish Reo for his motion since Lindstedt fails to direct us to any legal authority or basis.

The appeal shall proceed and be set for hearing on the merits.
