This matter is presented on these motions.

The motion of plaintiff Bryan Anthony Reo [plaintiff Reo] in limine to exclude and disqualify defendant Martin Lindstedt from testifying is denied.

The motion of defendant Pastor Martin Lindstedt [defendant Lindstedt] to re-open and set aside Bryan Reo's fraudulent and malicious ex parte and in abstenia stalking judgment achieved via perjury and add Bryan Reo's father and Ohio lawyers to the trial is denied.

The motion of defendant Lindstedt to add Bryan Reo's co-conspirator father Anthony D. Reo as a party to the consolidated case is denied. Anthony D. Reo presently is named as a party in a pleading filed by defendant Lindstedt. However, to date defendant Lindstedt has failed to commence the action against him because no Civ.R. 4 service of process has been obtained against him.


The court reserves ruling until after the trial on the motion of defendant Lindstedt under Civ.R. 11 and R.C. 2323.51(A) to sanction plaintiff Reo and his counsel, Brett Klimkowsy, for filing a perjurious and lawless motion in limine to prevent defendant Lindstedt from testifying.

The separate motions of plaintiff Reo, defendant Lindstedt and defendant Roxie Fausnaught to continue the August 1, 2017 jury trial is granted. **Jury trial is reset to January 23, 2018, at 8:30 a.m.**

Last, in reviewing the Journal Entry of April 11, 2017, the court finds that the names "William Shawn DeClue and Clifton Emahiser" were erroneously included in the list of

defendants against whom no service was obtained. As service was obtained against DeClue and Emahiser, the claims asserted by defendant Lindstedt against them remain pending and are not dismissed.
