ORDER

This matter comes before this Court upon Motions for Continuance, one filed by Attorney Brett Klimkowsky on behalf of Bryan Reo, the other Motion filed by Pastor Martin Lindstedt pointing out that Roxie Fausnaught has recently suffered a broken hip.

After due consideration and for good cause shown, there shall be a Continuance granted for at least three months to give Roxie Fausnaught a chance to heal until mid-October 2017.
